Wood – the colors used to represent the element wood include greens and browns. They take on the meaning of growth, hope and rebirth.



Fire – the colors used to represent the element fire include purples, pinks, reds, oranges and dark yellows. They take on the meaning of wealth, love and reputation.



Earth – the colors used to represent the element earth include light yellows, beige, taupe and light browns. They take on the meaning of stability and nourishment.



Metal – the colors used to represent the element metal include white and grays. They take on the meaning of clarity and creativity.



Water – the colors used to represent the element water include blues and black. They take on the meaning of purity and wisdom.
